

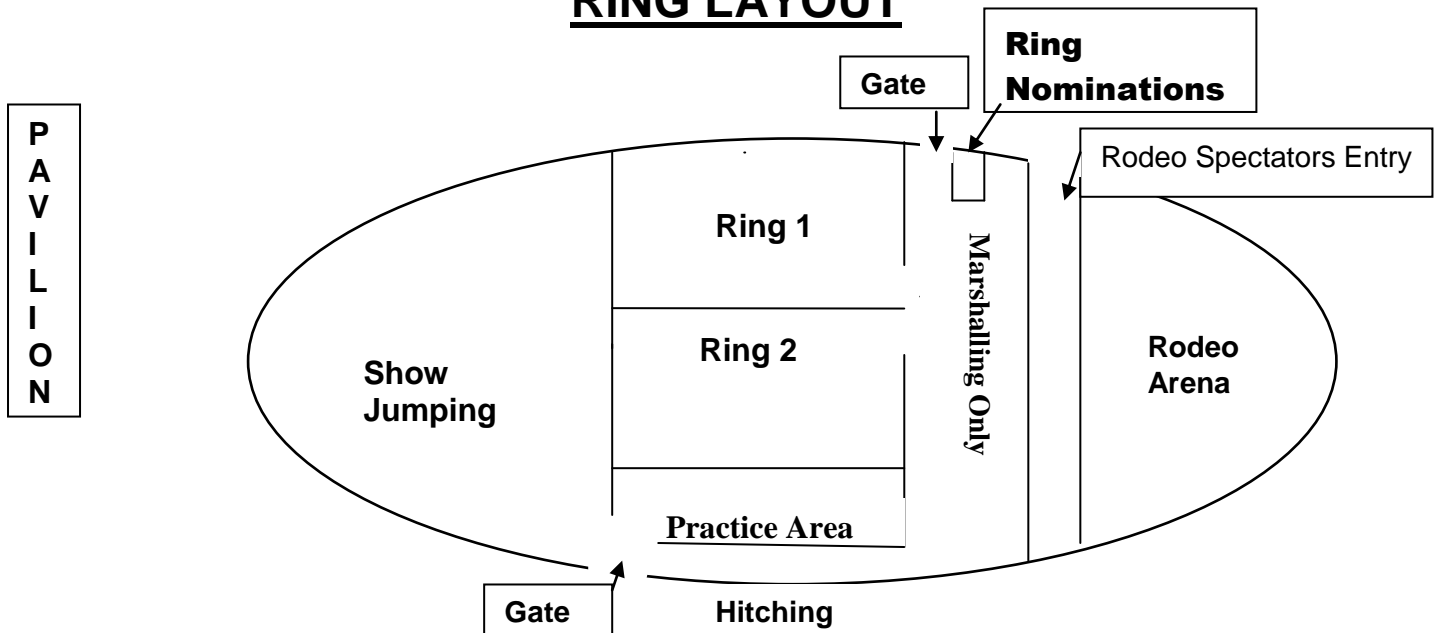

RING EVENTS: CONDITIONS OF ENTRY	
1.	Start time 8.00 sharp.
2.	Competitors ride at their own risk.
3.	Gate Admission price WILL NOT be refunded.
4.	All prize money must be collected on Saturday 21 August 2010. Uncollected money becomes a donation to Mary Valley Show Society.
5.	All point score cards to be delivered to Steward at commencement of their events and not collected until event has been judged.
6.	Junior riders competing in open events CANNOT compete in age groups. In Show Jumping the EFA Junior Rule applies, unless otherwise stated.
7.	All Led-in classes will be judged before Riding Classes start.
8.	NO HOLDING UP of program for dual registered horses.
9.	The Committee reserves the right to ALTER or CANCEL any event, measure any horse or pony it deems necessary, and to inspect certificates for classes.
10.	The Committee requests all Judges to make POSITIVE DECISIONS & avoid tied placing.
11.	The Judge is under no obligation to award a Champion Ribbon if in his/her opinion the horse does not merit the award.
12.	Stallions or Colts over 2 years to be exhibited in a bridle or halter with Chain or Bar & Chain.
13.	Owners or Handlers of stallion exhibits with unruly behavior will be asked to remove them from the grounds.
14.	A Maiden is an animal that has never won a 1 st prize in any similar competition for which it is competing at an Agricultural Show.
15.	A Novice is a horse that has not won a championship at an Agricultural Show.
16.	District horses to be from a 50 km radius of Imbil.
17.	Horses eligible for Champion Classes must be ridden by rider with whom they qualified.
18.	DISPUTES COMMITTEE will consist of the Chief Ring Steward, uninvolved Class contestants, two uninvolved Stewards. Disputes MUST BE HANDED to Chief Ring Steward within half an hour ACCOMPANIED BY \$50.00.
